Our handbook has a Zero Tolerance Policy, Dispute Resolution Policy and Policy on Conduct outline in our handbook. All players, parents and coaches should read and be aware of these policies. Additionally, a Travel Code of Conduct for players, coaches, parents and all representatives of SRYHA is also in the handbook.

This states:

- Participating in the SRYHA travel hockey is a privilege.
- You represent the SRYHA at all times and are expected to act in a manner that does not embarrass yourself, your team, your peers, the SRYHA and its Corporate Sponsors.
- Individuals in the travel party should report any incidents to the Team Manager.
- The Team Manager will present SRYHA concerns to the tournament hosts, restaurant and/or the hotel management.
- The Team Manager will document and incidents and report them immediately upon the team;s return to the SRYHA Executive Board.
- Any and all follow-up correspondence will be sent on the Associations behalf by the SRYHA President.
- Anyone associated with the SRYHA travel group who violates the travel code of conduct will be subject to Zero Tolerance disciplinary actions outlined in the SRYHA handbook.
